On behalf of the Linkville Lopers Running and Walking Club, I sincerely thank you for the grant funds that were awarded to our organization.

Our marketing dollars were spent on two feature ads in Trail Runner magazine. We saw a 20% increase in overall attendance from 2014 and of the 105 registered runners, 56 were from outside the county. We feel this is largely in part to the advertisements, and from having nationally recognized vendors supporting the event. We received registrations, outside of Oregon, from: Alaska, Florida, California, Washington, and Georgia.

Also part of the event, was the Trails in Motion Film Festival, held at the Ross Ragland Cultural Center. We had 56 people attending the event held on 9/26/15. Twenty two of those tickets purchased were from out of county and were also running the following day. We have an on-line registration platform that was used to gain accurate metrics for the numbers provided.

The event gained regional attention from a news team that traveled over from Medford. Please review the enclosed DVD for access to the materials. Many of the visitors were already planning return trips to Crater Lake and the surrounding areas. We're already brainstorming ways to reach an even broader audience for next year.
