

**IVORY PINE ROAD BRIDGE REPLACEMENT DESIGN BUNDLE**

**I. ANNOUNCEMENT**

Proposals for developing plans and specifications for the full replacement of Bridge 35C219 (Ivory Pine over the Sprague River) and the timber substructure replacement for Bridge 35C223 (Ivory Pine over Meryl Creek) will be received by Michael J. Zarosinski, P.E., County Engineer for Klamath County Public Works, 305 Main Street, Klamath Falls, OR 97601, until 10:00 a.m., local time, September 10, 2019. FACSIMILE PROPOSALS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE. As soon thereafter as possible, the proposals will be reviewed and evaluated by a Klamath County appointed Selection Committee. There is no required pre-proposal meeting.

It is estimated the duration of the project will be between 18 and 40 months with Consultant fees in the range of \$300,000.00 to \$500,000.
