WHEREAS, the Social Games Ordinance No. 21.01 passed by the Klamath County Board of Commissioners on December 4, 1980, established a fee under Section 2 in the Ordinance for card table licenses, and provided for reduced fees for nonprofit society, club, or fraternal organizations in Section 5 of the Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, because of changing economic conditions to include inflationary or deflationary trends, the Board of County Commissioners wishes to be able to change the license fees for social games without amending the Ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordained the Ordinance be amended as follows:

1. Section 2 shall be amended as follows:

"There shall be collected for each card table licensed hereunder, except as provided in Section 7 of this Ordinance, a fee [*of \$100.00 per year*] **to be determined periodically by Order of the Board of County Commissioners and to be effective thirty (30) days after passage of the Order by the Board of County Commissioners.**"


2. Section 5 to be changed as follows:

"A nonprofit society, club, or fraternal organization having adopted bylaws and duly elected directors and members may be granted a social gaming license at an


annual fee [of \$25.00] to be determined periodically by Order of the Board of County Commissioners and to be effective thirty (30) days after passage of the Order by the Board of County Commissioners per table when it appears that the tables are for the exclusive use of members of the society, club or fraternal organization, no charge is made for participation, and the conduct of social games is not the primary reason for existence of the society, club, or fraternal organization. The society, club, or fraternal organization shall have been in continuous existence, actively conducting its affairs in the County of Klamath for a period of two years immediately preceding application for a license. The annual fee is payable on or before January 1 of each year, and shall be prorated for new applicants for the period of July 1 to December 31 to one-half the annual fee."

This Amendment to the Social Games Ordinance is to be effective ninety (90) days after signature by the Board of County Commissioners.
