COMMUNITY UPDATE HOW ARE PUBLIC FUNDS BEING PUT TO WORK IN 2021?

Internal Work Forces

In 2021 the items below highlight some of the scheduled work for this year.

- Construct 127 miles of chip seals to roads maintained by Klamath County and 3 miles of roads maintained by the City of Klamath Falls.
- Construct 18.5 miles of fog seal application to paved county roads and 3 miles of roads maintained by the City of Klamath Falls.
- Construct 19.76 miles of Dust Off to aggregate County roads.
- Construct a skinny patch asphalt overlay to a combined 1.75 miles of paved County roads.
- Constructing crack seal, asphalt patching, and mastic construction over 140 miles of County roads.
- Replaced the bridge, over an irrigation canal, on West Langell Valley Road with a new box culvert.
- Installing rapid reflective flashing beacon systems at multiple bicycle and pedestrian crossing locations.
- Managed project for the replacement of 70 sidewalk ramps and the production of 13,400 cubic yards of chip aggregate.

External Work Forces through Contracting

- Reconstruct 70 sidewalk ramps and the intersection at Maryland Ave and Homedale Road.
- Contract with irrigation districts to clean and pipe a portion of the Klamath County Drainage Service District canals.
- Replacing the bridge, over the Sprague River, on Ivory Pine Road with a new bridge.
